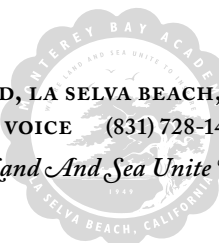

tournament rules and instructions

1. **Four-person scramble.** Each player tees off (men from back tees, women from forward tees). After all four drives, choose the best one and pick up the other three (3). After replacing golf balls within one (1) club length of the best shot (no closer to the pin or improving out of hazards), each player hits again. All putts must be holed out. Count one team score on card.
2. **Drives.** Each team must use at least two (2) drives from each player (on any of the 18 holes). Please mark accordingly on scorecard.
3. **Threesomes.** In the even that a team must play as a threesome, in order to be eligible for all prizes, they can only hit one shot per person. They do **not** get to rotate and hit a fourth (4th) shot—that is too much of an unfair advantage.
4. **Mulligans.** Mulligan tickets are available before the tournament for \$5.00 each (maximum two (2) per player). The mulligans can be used on any shot (not just drives) during the tournament by the player who purchased them (no trading!). Mulligans should be declared and that player gets a second (2nd) shot. However, **no mulligans may be used on the contest holes for prizes.** You must count your first shot only on contest holes.
5. **Scoring.** A team captain shall keep each group's scorecard. There are prizes for first (1st) through third (3rd) place in two (2) categories:
Overall low gross score
Low net score (with group handicaps factored in).
Any team winning the overall category is not eligible to win in the Low Net category as well. The first name of the scorecard is the team captain. Turn in signed cards at the end of the day as soon as you complete your round.

Net scoring as follows:

90+	-4
86-89	-3
81-85	-2
77-80	-1
76 and below	0

Each player's score is added to get a team score. A team's maximum handicap is -16. At the end of the day, the team handicap will be subtracted from the overall score for a Low Net score. Threesomes will have the fourth (4th) averaged in.

6. **PRIZES!** Putting contest (10:00-11:30a). Each golfer is eligible for one free try in the putting contest. Additional turns cost \$5.00 each. There will be a prize for both men's and women's categories.

Prize Holes

- #6 Closest To The Pin
- #8 Closest To The Pin
- #9 Longest Drive (Men's and Women's — must be in fairway cut)
- #12 Closest To The Pin
- #14 Closest To The Pin
- #16 Closest To The Pin (Men's—175 yards, Women's—160 yards minimum)

Hole-In-One wins grand prize! (No practice shots—one (1) ball only)

Note: Women must hit from the gold tees to qualify for the grand prize—this hole only!

7. **Raffle.** Each player will receive one raffle ticket in their goody bag. Additional tickets may be purchased for \$2.00 each. Discounts are 3 tickets for \$5.00, 7 for \$10.00, or 15 for \$20.00. When you finish your round, check the board to see if your raffle numbers have won any prizes.
8. **Etiquette.** Please remember golf course etiquette at all times. **Keep up with the group ahead of you. Fight slow play.**
9. **Tiebreaker.** In case of a tie, the handicapped holes on the scorecard will break the tie.

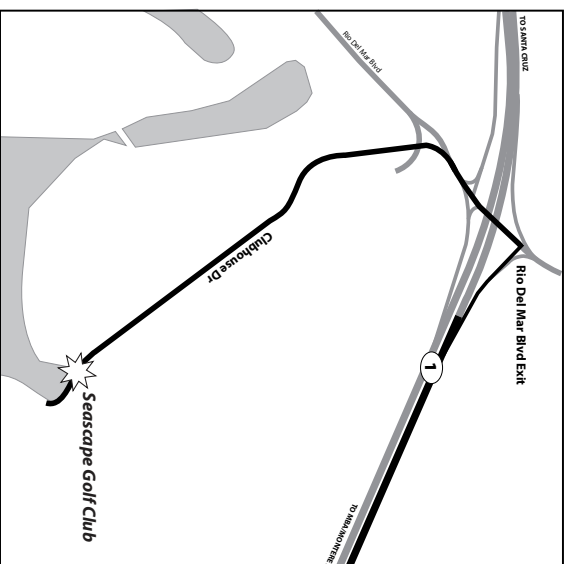
